Maximum handicap: Men 28 Ladies 36

With the exception of Trophy winners Competitors handicaps will remain unaltered for the duration of the Meeting. Trophy winners (and their partners) will have their handicaps reduced by 1 shot each time they win and these new handicaps will apply for any subsequent competitions that they enter.

Events 1, 4, and 6 are Qualifying Competitions for Handicap purposes. It is the responsibility of visiting Competitors to report their scores to their Home Club. The CSS for these competitions will be published on the Maesdu website (maesdugolfclub.co.uk) at the end of the Meeting.

In the event of a tie for any Trophy the score over the last 9, 6, 3, 1 holes will decide.
(For 36 holes the last 18, 9, 6 etc., will decide).

The draw for the Wednesday semi-finals of the MAESDU and TATLOW Challenge Trophies will be posted in the Clubhouse by 10 am on Tuesday. The onus for ascertaining if a competitor has qualified for these match play stages rests with him and he should inform the Committee as soon as possible if he is unable to compete in them. Full Handicap difference applies in the match play stages of these competitions

It is a condition of the Meeting that only equipment and balls included in the current R&A approved lists are to be used. Competitors are allowed to use distance-measuring devices.

The Committee will resolve any disputes and its decision shall be final.

Please note that Club Dress Rules, on and off the course, should be adhered to at all times.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF MAESDU SEPTEMBER OPEN WEEK

The September Open Meeting was introduced by our first Club Professional, **Tom Jones**, in 1922 and was among the first of such events within the UK. The Meeting has always been held in September because Llandudno Town Council, who sponsored the first Meeting, requested that it took place during early September in order to extend the Town's holiday season.

The initial Meeting comprised of Singles competitions for the **Duncan Challenge Bowl** and **Chantry Scratch Challenge Trophy**, and Pairs competitions for the **Grand Challenge Tankards** and the **Mixed Challenge Cup**. These competitions have remained an integral part of the Meeting ever since.

Additional competitions and trophies were introduced on a regular basis and the original five day meeting gradually grew into today's ten day event. The majority of trophies that we now play for have their origins back in the 1920's, 30's, and 40's, although in some cases the format of a competition has been changed to embrace new ideas. For example the original **Mixed** competition was played as a Foursome but this year is being played in the more popular Better Ball format and the **Oxfords Cups** (which were donated in 1929 by the old Oxford Garage) started life as a Foursome versus Bogey pairs competition. In this form of Par/Bogey competition it was the pair's foursome score for a hole that was matched to the par of the hole. The **Cups** are now played in the more acceptable Fourball Better Ball format.

A 1940's addition to Open Week was the **Coast Artillery Cup**, a trophy donated to the Club in 1945 by the Coastal Artillery School (C.A.S.) as a thank you for affording their staff honorary membership during their temporary relocation to Llandudno. The School moved from Shoeburyness in Essex; considered too vulnerable to attack at that time; to a new site on the Great Orme; which it occupied from 1940 to 1945.

The **Tom Jones Senior Trophy** for competitors aged 55 and over was added to the Week in 1965 to honour its founder, who in 1962 had become the first Club Professional to be appointed as a Club Captain and who served as Chairman of the PGA from 1962 to 1967.
