



MEN'S CLUB COMPETITIONS

TEE TIMES: Competitors can enter Club Competitions by booking an available tee time between **7.30am and 3.30pm.**

These tee times are restricted to Competitors only for the three Major Club Competitions (Captains Day, Presidents Day and Chairman's Day).

Tee times between 7.30am to 9.38am are also restricted to Competitors only for all Saturday Club Competitions.

Tee times are booked via the BRS Online Booking System and are available for booking 9 days prior to each Competition.

COMPETITION ENTRY: Competitors must register their entry into a Competition by paying their Entry Fee (and collecting their scorecard) from the Professional Shop.

The Entry Fee for Competitions is **£3.00** per Competitor per round.

The Professional's Two's sweep is an optional **£1.00** per Competitor per round.

NOTES: (i) Competitors who, without prior notification, fail to appear to play at their booked tee time risk suspension from Competitions.

(ii) Competitors may not play at any time other than the time they have booked.
Penalty – disqualification from Competition (Rule 6.3a applies)

PRIZE FUND

Board Competitions:

18 Hole Singles	1 st £70, 2 nd £40, 3 rd £20, 4 th £10
18 Hole over-55 Singles	1 st £60, 2 nd £30, 3 rd £15
18 Hole Pairs	1 st £40 each, 2 nd £20 each, 3 rd £10 each
Eddie Grace & May Bowl	1 st £70, 2 nd £40 for each Division
Club Championship	as 18 hole singles plus £70 Best Gross

Non-board Competitions:

18 Hole Singles	1 st £60, 2 nd £30, 3 rd £15
18 Hole Pairs	1 st £30 each, 2 nd £15 each, 3 rd £8 each
Monthly Medals	1 st £30, 2 nd £15, 3 rd £8 for each Division

NOTES:

* The published prize values for 'Non-board Competitions' will only be paid in full if there are sufficient entries to cover their cost. These prizes will not be increased beyond their published value but will be reduced if less than 40 competitors take part.

* A Competition will be cancelled if there are less than 10 entrants.

* Members who do not hold a competitive handicap (i.e a non 'c' handicap) can enter Competitions to regain their 'c' status but are not eligible for a prize.

SCORECARDS: Competitors must always return their Scorecards (whether complete or not) and must, when required to do so by the Conditions of the Competition, enter their hole-by-hole score into the Computer Terminal situated in the Sports Bar – CONGU Decisions 1(p) and 1(m). Failure to do so may result in suspension from Competitions.

Details of each Competition (including Conditions of Entry, Method of Play, Tees, Handicap Allowance etc.) will be posted in the Clubhouse during the week preceding the Competition.
